



## School celebrates

ORSETT CE Primary School students have returned to school to celebrate two successes.

Firstly the school received top results in an inspection, and then was lauded as one of the country's top schools for progress between Key Stage 1 and 2.

The inspection was a Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools. All church schools are required to be inspected under a framework similar to OFSTED with a specific focus on: Christian Character, Collective Worship, Religious Education and Leadership and Management, and the

inspection judged Orsett CE Primary School to be Outstanding.

The report stated that: "Outstanding leadership has secured improved achievements for pupils across all subject areas including RE, thereby increasing educational and life chances for every child."

Headteacher, Lallie Godfrey (pictured above with pupils) said: "Last year we had an OFSTED Inspection under the new and rigorous framework and our school was judged to be Good with Outstanding for Behaviour and Safety
