

## CLUBS Autumn 2017

Dear Parents

As you know we believe that extra-curricular activities really do give children the opportunity to discover other areas of interest as well as the opportunity to improve skills further and it is by aiming to provide a wide variety of clubs that we can further enrich your child's education.

This term we are offering clubs that have been requested by the children from their class forum. There will be **17** clubs (including those from outside providers), which offer a wide variety of choice – hopefully something for every child! All clubs (unless otherwise stated) will begin during the week beginning **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017** and will finish the week ending **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2017**. If for any reason a member of staff has to cancel a club we will aim to inform you as soon as is possible by text-outdoor clubs will be accommodated indoors where possible, if the weather is bad.

The majority of clubs are run by our staff who are giving up their own valuable time voluntarily and I would like to thank them for their commitment and enthusiasm. The paid clubs and some other clubs have been subsidised by the Sports Premium Grant-these have been marked with an \*.

**Pro-Am Sports** will, once again, run a school football programme for **all** year groups after school on Thursdays. This club will need to be paid for and details as well as separate registration forms will be sent out once we have them. **Stanford Warriors** Jujitsu Club will continue on a Monday after school. Again, anyone wishing their child to join these clubs will need to contact the organisers (the easiest way to do this is to speak to them on the day that they are at our school).

⇒ Clubs that are run before school will run from **8:00am to 8:40am**, at lunchtime will run from **12:40 p.m. to 1:15 p.m.** and after school clubs will run from **3:30 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.**

Any children who attend the clubs are expected to attend on a regular basis as often the teachers will have planned specifically for the number of children attending. In some cases, we will have to limit the numbers due to the number of computers available. If any child regularly fails to turn up to a club (without a reasonable excuse) the teacher running the club will then replace this child with another on a waiting list.

All after school clubs will finish **promptly** at **4:15 p.m.** and we would ask that parents are ready to take their children home at that time as often staff has other meetings or commitments that they have to attend after this time. We are also unable to supervise siblings who are not attending the clubs and therefore any siblings must be collected at the end of the school day.

Overleaf is a list of the clubs available this term together with the name of the member(s) of staff running the club, the Year Groups able to take part and the maximum number of children that can take part at any one time. **It has been agreed that Reception children will be offered clubs from January, so as to allow them to settle in this term.**

This term we are continuing with the new online booking system which has been created to make the process of booking your child's places for clubs much quicker and simpler to organise.

The system enables you to log in and book (and pay for) clubs at a time to suit you. Each club has a limited number of spaces and the online booking system only allows the number of children permitted to be booked in. You will therefore receive immediate confirmation of your child's place and will not need to wait for a reply slip from the school. ## Booking Your Child Onto A Club in 3 Simple Steps

### Step 1: Find your school

Click on 'I'm a parent – find a club'

Type your child's school name/postcode to find the school.

### Step 3: Book on to the club

If the club is free, simply click book for free, making sure you tick the medical authorisation box.
