Leadership & Management

- 1) To continue to build on the capacity for Leadership across the school
- 2) To ensure all Leaders have an accurate and comprehensive understanding of the quality of education in school, through effective monitoring relating to impact
- 3) To develop the governance role of leadership on transition through to academy status
- 4) To build on links through The Vine MAT

Teaching, Learning & Assessment

- 1) To maintain a focus on improving writing across the whole school
- 2) To ensure that Assessment for Learning (AFL) incorporates mastery teaching
- 3) To ensure LOTs assessments are embedded across the school
- 4) To ensure that basic skills are the core of all teaching and learning

Pupils' Outcomes

- 1) Ensure the vast majority (90%) of pupils, in maths and English, are working at or above ARE
- 2) Ensure the HA are suitably challenged-35% of pupils are working at above ARE
- 3) To ensure marking and feedback, in all subjects, continues to be of a consistently high quality
- 4) To ensure interventions are specific to pupils' needs

Personal Development, Behaviour & Welfare

- 1) To increase opportunities throughout the curriculum for pupils to think, speak and listen analytically and reflectively
- 2) To improve pupils' understanding of social/cultural and moral issues as well as life choices
- 3) To seek opportunities to create a safe and sustainable route to and from school

Safeguarding

- 1) To continue to work with parents and pupils to increase their understanding of effective e-safety wherever the child is
- 2) To continue to ensure behavioural/CP issues are recorded accurately
- 3) Ensure that all staff understand their roles in risk assessment
- 4) Ensure that all staff receive updated training in the care and protection of pupils
