

Dear Parents

As a part of our school's aim to enrich the curriculum for our children by providing additional experiences which will enhance their learning, we are currently looking into the possibility of arranging a residential trip for Class 5 to Bradwell Outdoors Centre from **Wednesday 19th June** and **Friday 21st June 2019**.

In order for this to take place we would be asking for a contribution towards the costs from parents of **£170**. This will include all meals, accommodation, activities and transport. The children will take part in activities such as sailing, mountain biking, crabbing and boat trip, raft building and archery as well as a range of fun evening activities. The accommodation will be in a tented village which is made up of four and eight person bunk house tents each with lighting, bunk beds and a solid base. The village also includes a multipurpose marquee with lighting, tables and chairs and games i.e. table tennis, table football.

As a school, we are able to support children who are in receipt of Free School Meals and/or in hardship and in these cases please do go in and meet Miss Jones who will explain this further (all conversations will be confidential).

In order to ascertain the viability of the trip before we book it, we would ask that you complete the slip below and return in by **Monday 24th September**.

Obviously, **if we do not have enough positive responses** regarding both taking part and being prepared to contribute **the trip will not go ahead**. Once we know whether the trip is affordable and have booked it we will contact you with further details.
