H.M.S. TITANIC

Instructions

Pick a starter, main and dessert. You can choose from either the third class (standard fare), second class (a little more challenging), or first class (for a deluxe challenge).

	Third Class	Second Class	First Class
Starter	Create a fact file about the Titanic including: when it was made, how many passengers it had, who made it and where it was going.	Find or draw a picture of the Titanic and label the key features of the ship such as the different decks, where the cabins were, the dining room etc.	Explain why the Titanic was described at the time as EITHER being 'unsinkable' OR 'the greatest ship ever built'.
Main	Write a newspaper report the day after the Titanic sunk. You should include a detailed description of what happened whilst the ship was sinking and how many people survived.	Write a report explaining why more third class passengers died than first class passengers.	Imagine that you are Walter Lord's defence lawyer. Write a persuasive argument explaining why he was not to blame for the sinking of the Titanic and who exactly was to blame.
Dessert	Design a poster advertising the Titanic. Include lots of pictures and colours and the types of things you can do on board.	Design and write a postcard (front and back) for someone on the Titanic. Describe what they have done on board, what they have eaten and how they feel about the journey.	Design a brochure advertising the Titanic. You should include information about the different facilities for those in first, second and third class.
